Turkey Noodle Dinner...March 5th 2009

We are already making a schedule of volunteers for this fundraiser. Here are the areas we need help:

Food Prep: making noodle, pie filling, pies & de-boning turkey

Advertisers & Ticket Sellers: starting Feb 1st

Making Pie Shells: 2 day commitment during the daytime hours

Pie Bakers: Tuesday March 4th

Pie cutters: that afternoon from 1:00p-?

Haulers: to take things to Community Church around 1:30pm

Haulers: men to take equipment to church on Monday March 3rd after 5pm

Haulers: Take dirty dishes & equipment back to the soup kitchen at 7:00pm that night

Servers: that night (2 shifts 3:30-5:30pm & 5-7ish)

Car Greeters: that night (2 shifts 3:30-5:30pm & 5-7ish)

Traffic Controllers: 4 men to stand in the cold for a 45 minute shift (3:45-4:30, 4:30-5:15, 5:15-6, 6-7pm)

Extras: a couple of you willing to do whatever to help things run smoothly or to fill in if someone is sick or doesn't show up.

Clean up: 7pm

It is going to take about 80 volunteers to pull this off!
